Antalya (TUR), 14 - 18 October 2015

GENERAL REGULATIONS



PARTICIPATION

1. Only the National Federations or Committees duly affiliated to UWW for the year 2015 can participate in the event. They are fully responsible for entering their athletes within the deadline.
2. National Federations or Committees can enter a maximum of 2 athletes per weight category for seniors and a maximum 3 competitors per weight category in Cadets and Juniors classes.
3. Each competitor (cadet, junior, senior, veteran) must have a UWW license valid for the year. For the license, the following documents are requested: a passport copy, an annual medical certificate and a photo. The licenses are exclusively sold at competition and the price is CHF 100.- (or 100.- Euros or 110.- US\$) for Seniors, Juniors & veterans and CHF 50.- (or 50.- Euros or 50.- US\$) for cadets. Temporary licences CHF 30.- (or 30.- Euros or 30.- US\$) for Juniors and Cadets.
4. Each senior competitor must be 20 or older. Competitors aged 18-19 are allowed to participate upon presentation of a medical certificate.
5. Each cadet competitor must be 16-17 years old (born 1998-1999). Each junior competitor must be 18-19 years old (born 1996-1997).
6. Each Veteran-A competitor must be 35 - 45 years old (born between 1970-1980), each Veteran-B competitor must be 46-56 years old (born between 1959-1969). Age and nationality will be checked with the passport at the weigh-in.
7. Each athlete must pass a medical exam in his home country at least three days before leaving for competition. They must provide a medical certificate.
8. Each contestant deemed to be taking part of his/her own free will, responsible for him/her, shall be allowed to compete in only one weight category: the one corresponding to his weight at the time of the official weigh-in.
9. Preliminary entries (number of participants) must be sent to orhanim38@hotmail.com and UKR@fila-pankration.com (World Pankration Committee) before **01 September 2015**.
10. Final entries (participants' name) must be sent to Turkey Pankration Federation and WPC before **01 October 2015**.
11. The delegations in need of a visa to enter Turkey must send their visa application forms to before **01 September 2015**.
12. By prior request the delegations will be welcomed by the organizing committee upon their arrival in Antalya International Airport and will be driven to the venue to proceed with accreditation.
13. The delegations will benefit from a full accommodation package from the organizer (including transfer from/to airport, board and lodging) of **60 EUR per day per person** (in the Hotel XAFIRA DELUXE).
14. The competitors will pay a participation fee of **Euros 60.-** for Seniors competitors, **Euros 40.-** for Juniors and **Euros 30.-** for Cadets to the organizer, payable cash at accreditation to the organizer.
15. Competitors are under the exclusive responsibility of their National Federation or Committee through their respective coaches. Any breach of the rules will be sanctioned according to the UWW Disciplinary Regulations.

TECHNICAL CONDITIONS

1. The competition will be run according to the UWW Pankration official rules on 3 UWW approved mats.
2. The competition will take place in the official weight categories and no weight allowance will be accepted:

Cadets (Boys) 39-42, 46, 50, 54, 58, 63, 69, 76, 85, 100 kg

Cadets (Girls) 36-38, 40, 43, 46, 49, 52, 56, 60, 65, 70 kg

Juniors (Men)	57, 62, 66, 71, 77, 84, 92, + 92 kg
Juniors (Women)	49, 53, 58, 64, 71, + 71 kg
Seniors (Men)	57, 62, 66, 71, 77, 84, 92, 100, +100 kg
Seniors (Women)	53, 58, 64, 71, + 71 kg
Veterans (Men)	62, 66, 71, 77, 84, 92, 100, +100 kg
Veterans (Women)	53, 58, 64, 71, + 71 kg

- Each competitor will be requested to undergo a medical examination before the official weigh-in, during which his/her competition uniforms will be inspected for compliance as well.
- The drawing of lots for position in the brackets will be done manually at the time of weigh-in.
- The competitors are allowed to enter several styles: Cadets, Juniors, Veterans and Seniors women Pankration-traditional. Seniors men Pankration-elite.
- Competitors who forfeit a match without proper medical certificate will not be allowed to proceed throughout the tournament (even in other styles) and will be withdrawn from the final ranking.
- The UWW license covers medical assistance to the competitors in the event of an accident occurring during the competition. If a competitor wishes to have a medical examination or receive a treatment that is not linked to an accident that happened during the competition, either he/she or his/her National Federation will be entitled to bear the related costs.
- Each competitor will be required to wear the UWW WPC approved competition uniform complying with the international regulations that is:

Pankration-tradition: Mandatory black shorts and blue or red rashguard, 4oz gloves and shin-instep guards. The first competitor called shall wear black shorts, red rashguard and red protections, the second one black shorts, blue rashguard and blue protections.

In addition, competitors in traditional divisions are required to wear a groin guard and a mouth guard. Female competitors are also allowed to wear a chest protector.

Pankration-elite: Mandatory black shorts and blue or red rashguard, head guard, 6oz gloves and shin-instep guards. The first competitor called shall wear black shorts, red rashguard and red protections, the second one black shorts, blue rashguard and blue protections.

In addition, competitors in full divisions are required to wear a groin guard and a mouth guard.

9. World Pankration Committee approved uniforms and protections will be for sale on site or at [http:// www.berserk-sport.com/](http://www.berserk-sport.com/)

10. Individual prizes will be given to each weight category:

1 st place	1 gold medal, certificate
2 nd place	1 silver medal, certificate
3 rd places	2 bronze medals, certificates
5 th –10 th places	certificates

11. The first three teams in each style will receive a cup.

12. Points will be allocated to the first eight ranked in each weight category and will count for the World Ranking of athletes: 1st place - 17 points, 2nd place - 16 points, 3rd places - 15 points, 5th places - 13 points, 7th place - 11 points, 8th place - 10 points.

13. The organizer will conduct random anti-doping test among the gold medalists. The categories concerned will be selected and publicly announced at the end of the weigh-in. The laboratory used to analyses these tests will be IOC/WADA approved. The procedure for undertaking the tests and transporting the samples to the laboratory is laid down in the UWW Regulations and in WADA's Anti-Doping Code.

REFEREES

1. Only the UWW WPC certified referees with a valid 2015 licence may work in the competition.
2. All referees must wear black flat-front pants, black sport shoes, and the official UWW shirt and accessories.
3. All referees must attend the referees' course preceding the competition.

COACHES

1. Only one coach is allowed to the competitors' corner. The coaches must wear their national team tracksuit when performing their match duties and abide by the International Code of Conduct at all times.
